



Child Protection Policy for Parishes (Revised: June 2011)

Specific details relating to Time Travelling events are as follows:

1. In law, the children remain the responsibility of the teachers and other authorised representatives (*school adults*) of the school from which they come.
2. All volunteers must be known by the church leader from which the volunteer comes. The church leader then has the opportunity to comment if he/she has concerns. A programme of CRB checking is in process by Southwell and Nottingham Diocese on behalf of Time Travelling.
3. All volunteers receive training, which includes appropriate and inappropriate ways of working with children and the need to report any disclosure or concerns to the Time Travelling Manager.
4. Children needing the toilet are taken by a **school adult**.
5. No one-to-one activities take place, all Time Travelling children work in public settings with large numbers of others including teachers and school adults.
6. All activities are closely monitored by the Time Travelling Manager. Any issues or problems are dealt with immediately and can also be reviewed at training sessions.
7. Any complaints or concerns raised by teachers will be dealt with by the Time Travelling management.
8. Photography of events is covered in our photograph policy.
